HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

A clear starting point for a real backyard.

This manual helps homeowners organize the decisions that matter before installation. It is a planning handout—not a substitute for the written proposal, equipment manuals, local requirements, or project-specific safety guidance.

THE PRAIRIE APPROACH

Fit first. Features second.

Pool diameter, access, grade, drainage, utilities, equipment clearance, and daily use should be understood before selecting finish upgrades.

HOW THE YARD WILL BE USED

Keep service space in the plan. The tank diameter is only the starting point. Safe entry, equipment clearance, drainage, and any deck or shade structure require additional room.

FIVE STAGES / CLEAR RESPONSIBILITIES

From first conversation to owner handoff.

01**Tell us about the yard**

Share the city, available space, access, preferred size, timing, and how you want to use the pool.

PHOTOS + DIMENSIONS

02**Confirm what works**

Review delivery access, level area, drainage, nearby utilities, pump placement, and practical space around the tank.

SITE FIT

03**Separate needs from options**

The proposal identifies the base pool, delivery and installation, site requirements, and selected add-ons.

WRITTEN SCOPE

04**Deliver and install**

The approved installation scope includes tank placement, leveling the pool location, and pump installation.

INSTALL DAY

05**Know what you own**

Review operation, routine care, equipment access, and documentation tied to installed components.

OWNER HANDOFF

Project timing depends on access, site preparation, weather, selected upgrades, and scheduling. Prairie Pools provides a project-specific sequence after the scope is understood.

WHAT TO EXPECT

A prepared yard makes for a cleaner installation.

CONFIRMED INSTALLATION SCOPE Included in the quoted installation work • Delivery and tank placement • Leveling the pool location • Pump installation • Work specifically listed in the signed proposal	CONFIRM BEFORE ARRIVAL Homeowner preparation • Access route is clear • Pets and children are kept away from work areas • Vehicles and movable obstacles are relocated • Utility and trade requirements are understood • Final position is approved
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SITE-SPECIFIC WORK

Additional preparation, utilities, drainage improvements, decking, landscape repair, equipment upgrades, and finish carpentry are included only when listed in the proposal.

WEATHER + ACCESS

High wind, storms, saturated ground, blocked access, or incomplete prerequisite work may change the installation sequence.

PROJECT-SPECIFIC INSTALLATION NOTES

BUILD OUT ONLY WHAT THE YARD NEEDS

Start with the pool. Add with purpose.

01

Cedar work

Steps, ledges, and deck surrounds sized to the site and access needs.

02

Pool heater

A compatible heater considered with the complete equipment and utility plan.

03

LED lighting

Lighting selected for evening visibility and atmosphere.

04

Topper protector

An optional protector added to the final pool configuration.

SAFETY IS PART OF THE PLAN

Use layers of protection around every pool.

No website or handout replaces active supervision, compliant barriers, equipment instructions, and local requirements.

WATCH THE WATER

01

Active supervision

Never leave a child unattended in or near water. Designate an undistracted adult Water Watcher.

02

Limit unsupervised access

Use appropriate barriers, self-closing and self-latching gates, covers, alarms, or other layers required for the property.

03

No diving

Stock tank pools are shallow. Do not dive or jump headfirst.

04

Know the equipment

Keep people away from drains and suction openings. Do not use equipment with loose, broken, or missing covers.

05

Prepare for emergencies

Learn CPR, keep rescue equipment and a phone accessible, and know the exact property address.

06

Reestablish protection

After use, remove climbable objects and restore every barrier, cover, ladder control, and access safeguard.

Authoritative safety resources: U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission Pool Safety campaign – [PoolSafely.gov](https://www.poolsafely.gov). Confirm current local barrier, permit, electrical, and safety requirements for the project address.

A SIMPLE OWNERSHIP RHYTHM

Keep the water, equipment, and records in view.

RHYTHM	OWNER CHECK
Before use	Confirm the water is clear enough to see the bottom, entry is stable, barriers are restored, and visible equipment appears intact.
Routine	Test and balance water, check circulation, skim debris, and inspect the pool and accessible equipment according to the installed system instructions.
Filter service	Clean or service the filter according to its manufacturer instructions and actual pressure or flow conditions.
Weather plan	Follow system-specific procedures for heat, wind, dust, storms, freezing conditions, and seasonal operation.
When something changes	Stop using equipment that appears unsafe. Photograph the pool, equipment label, and issue before contacting support.
